Key issues arising with actions

- 12% of parents believe that St Austin's does not run enough after school clubs

Action: Sports' co-ordinator to organise further clubs – fencing/judo/football/rugby/Rainbows/street dance/ Curriculum booster classes/ multi-skills/ dodge ball

- 16% of parents state that their children do not enjoy school meals

Action: Head teachers raised issue at L.A. meeting and lunch menu has since been changed

- 12% of parents state that they do not understand the role of governors
