

Impact of Pupil Premium 2014/15

EYFS

The percentage of pupils achieving a good level of development has increased greatly. In comparison, academic year 2014-2015, 58% of pupils achieved a good level of development. In 2015-16, 70% of pupils achieved a good level of development.

Phonics

Y1 Phonics Screening Check. The percentage of Y1 pupils working at the expected standard was 83% in 2015 compared to 93% in 2014. 2 pupils from Year 2 who resat the test failed to achieve the pass mark.

KS1

At KS1 the percentage of pupils achieving a Level 2b+ in Reading rose from 75% in 2014 to 93% in 2015. Pupils achieving a Level 2b+ in Writing rose from 64% in 2014 to 83% in 2015. Pupils achieving a Level 2b+ in Numeracy rose from 75% in 2014 to 79% in 2015.

KS2

The percentage of pupils achieving a Level 5 in Reading rose from 41% to 45% in 2015. The percentage of pupils achieving a Level 4+ in Writing rose from 79% to 83%. The percentage of pupils achieving a Level 4+ in Mathematics rose from 83% to 93% in 2015. The percentage of pupils achieving a Level 5 in Mathematics remained constant at 34% in 2015. The percentage of pupils making expected progress in Mathematics remained constant at 86%. One child, 3%, attained Level 6. The percentage achieving a Level 5 in Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation rose from 45% to 62% in 2015. The percentage of pupils achieving a Level 4 in Writing, Reading and Mathematics combined rose from 69% in 2014 to 83% in 2015.
