Key issues arising with actions

- ✓ **30 %** of parents believe that the school website does not provides them with clear information regarding what has happened in school or about future actions.
- *Action:* Continue to update website with weekly newsletter and information. Revisit website design post SAT period.

- ✓ **28%** of parents do not believe that they are kept well-informed about what their child is learning in school or how to help them at home.**(22%)**
- *Action:* Curriculum maps/attendance/behaviour information displayed in entrance area.
Continue to display curriculum maps, events, calendar etc. on school website.
Continue to send weekly newsletters .
Information sessions for parents of pupils in Years2 and 6 to be organised.
Homework expectations to be displayed on windows facing parent pick-up area.
